It's great to together on another Lord's Day! If you are a guest at Robinson Avenue we are so glad that you are here; we ask for your patience as we continue to renovate our church auditorium. In the meantime we are enjoying the "togetherness" of packing into our fellowship building/gym for our morning assemblies.

On Wednesday nights in FUEL (and now on Sunday nights during our 6pm assemblies) we have been going through the New Testament book of I Thessalonians. In I Thess. 2:13 Paul resumes a prayer of gratitude that was started in I Thess. 1:2. Towards the end of this prayer in 2:19-20 he says these words: "For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of the

Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not you? Indeed, you are our glory and joy."

As I read these words from the apostle Paul I can't help but wonder: "Do I bring hope and joy to those who first shared Jesus with me? Would they say the same things about me?" I was fortunate to have godly parents who shared Christ with me – but they were not the only ones; there have been influential Youth Ministers, Bible class teachers, and camp counselors in my life as well. All of these people not only led me to Christ but have helped to disciple me. I can only hope that they feel the same way about me that Paul did about the Christians he had worked with in Thessalonica.

Of course our ultimate objective is to please God and do his will. Nevertheless, it is also important for us to be worthy heirs of those who first shared their faith with us. The Hebrew writer speaks these words: "Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their life and imitate their faith."

When Jesus returns I hope that there will be some people who I have taught who will be my "hope, joy, and crown" but I also hope that someone will see me in that same light. As we wait for that day let's continue to share and grow in our faith.

Good morning everyone! I hope that worship this morning is uplifting to you and that God was here among you!  
You know who isn’t here among you this morning? Part of the youth group! As you read this, six students, two interns, one adult, and I are backpacking our way up to base camp in Salida, CO. TREK is this week so please pray for our safety and that our week on the mountain revitalizes our relationship with God.

A couple of months ago, I had the opportunity to attend our annual Men’s Retreat for the second time. The fellowship was uplifting, the lessons were challenging, and the food was delicious. The thing I love about the retreats I’ve been on is that you come away with something that really sticks with you. For instance, this year we learned about the foundational beliefs of Christianity. I have since started the process of designing our youth ministry curriculum and several programs around the core beliefs. My thinking was changed on a personal level. It stuck with me and it is effecting change in how I go about teaching and doing ministry.

Last year’s Men’s Retreat was no exception. I took away many ideas about prayer and communicating with God, but I want to highlight on thing this morning. Our speaker, Mac Sandlin, recommended several books which I proceeded to buy. You know how it goes. You think you’ll read a book, so you buy it, you start reading it, and then you bog down and only make it a quarter of the way through. That is usually the case with me. However, A Diary of Private Prayer has been a different story. I really appreciate this book and what it offers. Here’s a little snippet of the book:  
“O Eternal God, although I cannot see you with my eyes or touch you with my hands, give me today a clear conviction of your reality and power. Do not let me go into my work believing only in the world of sense and time, but give me grace to understand that the world I cannot see or touch is the most real world of all. My life today will be lived in time, but it will involve eternal issues. The needs of my body will shout out, but it is for the needs of my soul that I must care the most.”  
I have really enjoyed this book and I hope this little excerpt encourages you as well
