Proclaiming the Resurrection

From the earliest days of the church Jesus’ resurrection has been shared

KEITH KILMER - Happy Easter! We are honored by the presence of each and every guest at Robinson Avenue today. Thank you for choosing to worship with us. Our prayer is that you will be inspired and encouraged though our time together in the presence of God today.

Kudos to all of our Leadership Training for Christ participants, sponsors, and mentors. Amy Ware and her team have worked so hard to get our kids ready for this weekend – and it really showed. I’m so proud of all our kids who participated. Be sure and mark Sunday night April 30 on your calendar - this will be a time to hear from, and celebrate the accomplishments of, all of our LTC participants.

The LTC theme this year was the book of Acts. One of the things that we learn in Acts is that the church grew as the apostles and others continued to testify to the Resurrection. Acts 4:33 says “With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God’s grace was so powerfully at work in them all.” This message hasn’t changed over the years – the empty tomb is a message of hope worth sharing with everyone. I’m happy that our young people are learning to share their faith – we need to be equally bold in our proclamation.

This morning our message with be centered on the power and ability of the Lord. The God who raised Jesus from the dead is still involved and active in our

lives. Paul prays this prayer in Ephesians 1:18-20: “I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead....” It is truly an amazing thought that God’s resurrection power is still at work within us – yet this is the promise of Scripture!
