- KEITH KILMER - Happy Mother’s Day! I hope that this will be a joyful and special day for all of our mothers. This morning we will be looking at the life of one mother in particular – the widow of Zarephath whose story is told in I Kings 17. This is a wonderful story of a single mom who had very little but grew tremendously in her faith as she learned to let go. I hope the story will be an encouragement not just to moms but to all of us as we learn to surrender ourselves to God.

There are so many reasons to cherish our mothers. Here are just a few:

- **Mothers show us what real joy is!** This is demonstrated from the very moment of birth (John 16:21) and continues through the life of their children.
 - **Mothers demonstrate unconditional love!** Who is better than a mother to give us a glimpse of the unconditional love of God? Titus 2:4 speaks of how older women are able to teach younger women to love their husbands and children. They are able to teach because they have become the “school of life and experience” has perfected their love.
 - **Mothers instruct us with wisdom!** Mothers are the teachers of the next generation. Their words, character, and values are instilled in the lives of their children (Prov. 31:26).
 - **Mothers are devoted!** Think about how Hannah devoted herself by giving her son Samuel to the Lord. Moms, your children will not be Christians by accident – you have a tremendous part in the faith of your children!
