Love Expressed Through Creation

God demonstrates his great love in many ways starting with creation

KEITH KILMER - Good morning! Our family is out of town today but our hearts remain with our Robinson Avenue family. I know that you will be blessed today as you worship God together. I'm grateful for Harry and Trent and the messages they will bring today. Open your ears and hearts to what God has to say through his humble and gifted servants.

Summer is often a time to be outdoors and return to nature. We work in the yard, we swim, we hike, we go for walks. All around us we see evidence of God's creativity and his love. God's first act of love is not the cross or even the grace of the Exodus. Creation is God's first loving act. Notice the words of the Psalmist in Psalm 136:-4-9: "To him who alone does great wonders, His love

endures forever. Who by his understanding made the heavens, His love endures forever. Who spreads out the earth upon the waters, His love endures forever. Who made the great lights, His love endures forever. The sun to govern the day, His love endures forever. The moon and starts to govern the night; His love endures forever."

Each act of creation testifies to God's great love for his people. And God continues to show his love by sustaining what he has made. The Hebrew writer points out that Jesus was involved with the Father in creation and continues to sustain the world – "The Son is the radiance of God's glory *and the exact representation* of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word." Again, the Psalms sound a

similar note: "All creatures look to you to give them their food at the proper time. When you give it to them they gather it up; when you open your hand they are satisfied with good things..."

I hope that we will enjoy God's creation during this time of year and, in fact, every time of year. Hopefully, we won't take for granted all that God has made and given. As you worship today consider God who is the Creator and Sustainer of all things and the giver of every good and perfect gift (James 1:17). Think on all that he has made and praise him!
