God's grace is expressed in many ways

KEITH KILMER - Good morning! We want to extend a warm welcome today to all of our members and guests. We hope that you will leave here encouraged and enriched in your faith. This morning we are beginning a new study in the book of Galatians – let's open our Bibles and open our hearts to this strong message of grace and freedom in Christ.

We use the term “grace” to describe many things in life. We say that a well-coordinated athlete or dancer is graceful. If someone responds to us with kind words, we might say that they are very gracious. We might describe a person who is merciful and forgiving as being full of grace.

God's grace is a many-splendored thing. It is

expressed to us in many ways. God's gift of salvation is certainly because of his grace but so is the sense of purpose that he gives to our lives. The spiritual gifts bestowed upon us by the Holy Spirit are literally grace gifts. God's grace is not only related to our salvation but also to our ministries, our calling, and our relationships. The Bible speaks truth when it speaks of Jesus as one who came “full of grace and truth.”

As recipients of grace, we are also called to be dispensers of grace. We are to give and demonstrate grace to our brothers, our family members, our employers or employees, and even to our enemies. It's in giving and extending grace that we truly come to appreciate the grace given to us. Is

there someone you can extend grace to this week? Is there anyone in your life who hasn't experienced grace? How might that person's life be changed by getting just a taste of God's grace dispensed through your own actions and attitude? Think about it!
