A Win-Win Scenario

The apostle Paul said: “For me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.”

KEITH KILMER - Good morning! Now that kids are back in school and the summer travel season is over it's a great time to welcome one another back and to encourage others to come into the fold. Be sure and mark your calendars for Sept. 17 which is Back to Church Sunday. We hope to fill our auditorium that day as we joyfully worship together.

There are many events scheduled and ministries set to resume shortly. Please be sure and read the inside of this bulletin for more details about what you can be involved in. One immediate opportunity is the Back to School fellowship that will take place at Tyson Park this afternoon from 4- 6 pm. We hope that your family can join us!

Paul wrote the book of Philippians while under Roman arrest. Unsure of his fate, Paul penned these words: “For me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body...” What a great perspective on life, death, and Christian service!

Some talk about win-win situations. A win-win game is a game which is designed in a way that all participants can profit from it in one way or the other. In conflict resolution, a win-win strategy is a collaborative strategy that

aims to accommodate all participants.

Paul saw his situation as a win-win. If his life were taken from him, this would only expedite his reunion with his Lord and Savior. Should his life be spared, he knew that this would only extend his life of service on earth. It was a win-win. In his heart of hearts, Paul anticipated the latter; he continued “...I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and joy in faith...” (v.25).

As Christians, we have a great future ahead of us. We have the joy and honor of living lives of service with the knowledge that one day we will be with the Lord. This is winning!
