In Step with the Spirit

God calls us to cooperate with the Spirit living in us

KEITH KILMER - We're glad you are here today! We want to be strengthened and mutually encouraged today but, above all, we want our Creator to be honored and glorified. We hope that everyone will return today for our 6 pm assembly as well. Tonight will feature two mission reports: Camp Wetoga and Trinidad. Robinson Avenue sent groups to each of these places, and they were a great blessing to inner-city kids from Atlanta as well as to children on the Caribbean island of Trinidad. Tonight we'll hear reports, watch videos, and see pictures of these trips. Also, there will be an ice cream social afterward, so you don't want to miss that!

Please mark your calendars for **Back to Church Sunday on Sept. 17!** We're really excited about how things are coming together for this special day. We'll have morning classes, followed by morning worship, followed by a special luncheon, followed by a time of song featuring the Good News Singers from Harding University. We hope to see lots of new and familiar faces on the 17th. Be thinking now about who you will invite.

This morning's focus is on Galatians 5:16-26. Paul gives us two contrasting portraits: a life lived according to the flesh, and a life lived according to the Spirit. Before giving us these portraits, he encourages us to "walk by the Spirit."

To walk by the Spirit means to listen to and cooperate with the Holy Spirit who is living in us. When we do this, there is a change in us that becomes evident and obvious to everyone we come in contact with. We become kinder and more gentle. We practice peace and forgiveness. We live our lives with self-control. Paul closes the passage with these words: "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit."

Today we have an opportunity to "worship in the Spirit" (John 4:24, Rev. 1:10). Let's set aside any distractions of the flesh and surrender ourselves in worship and praise this morning!
