Keeping Pace

We are to keep in step with the Spirit

KEITH KILMER - We're now just two weeks away from Back to Church Sunday! It's important that we identify who we would like to invite and begin extending those invitations. There are some invitation cards available in the fover if you would like something to place in someone's hand. Be thinking about and praying for those who have disconnected from their church family - what can we do to help them reconnect? It's going to be an exciting day of worship, song, and fellowship - let's share it with others!

In the meantime, we have a wonderful day of worship ahead of us. We're continuing today with the thought of living by the Spirit. Paul expresses this thought in various ways – he calls it "walking by the Spirit"

(Gal. 5:16), "being led by the Spirit" (5:18), "living by the Spirit" (5:25) and "keeping in step with the Spirit" (5:25).

As we draw near to the conclusion of our study of the book of Galatians, we will examine today some actions that match the attributes found in Gal. 5:22-23. When a person is living by the Spirit, it shows up in their character, behavior, and actions. A person who keeps pace with the Holy Spirit is someone who looks out for others by restoring them, helping them, and sharing with them (Gal. 6:1-6); they also are unrelenting in their pursuit of personal holiness (6:7-10).

The Apostle John was said to have been "in the Spirit on the Lord's Day" (Rev. 1:10). A spirit-led life is often prompted by times of worship. My prayer is that today will be such a day and that we will all leave here better prepared to keep pace with the Spirit.
