Our savior and Lord has invited us here

Keith Kilmer - Have you ever been especially honored by an invitation that you received? Maybe you were invited to your bosses' house. Perhaps you received an invitation to be the honoree at some significant event. It could be that a person who you greatly admire extended an invitation to you to eat and fellowship with him or her.

As we study and participate in the Lord's Supper this morning, please think about the fact that Jesus has invited us to gather around his table. This is the truth that we sing about when we sing the song He Meets Us Here with the line that says "He meets us here, he breaks the bread, the Lord who pours the cup is risen from the dead." Christ not only joins us but he serves us.

The Gospel of Luke tells us of many feasts, banquets, and dinners that Jesus participated in. Each occasion was an opportunity for him to impart grace and bless those in attendance. Some, like the Pharisees, missed the blessing because their hearts were hard; others, like Zacchaeus, were humbled and changed by their encounter with Christ. We know very little about the menu or food choices that were offered on these occasions – but all of that was secondary to the divine company that was kept.

What will become of us after we leave the Lord's table this morning? Will we leave unchanged like the Pharisees or humbled, repentant, and joyful like Zacchaeus? Much depends on our thoughts and attitudes as commune with Christ

and one another today. Let's accept this invitation with great joy and anticipation!
