## **Complete Unity**

Jesus prayed for the unity of the church

*Keith Kilmer -* This past week was very inspirational and encouraging. Last Sunday evening we gathered with brothers and sisters in Christ throughout Northwest Arkansas. Bruce McClarty delivered a wonderful message taken from John 17 and Jesus' prayer and plea for unity. Wednesday night was the "preacher exchange." I know that you were encouraged by Brother Irvine William's message here at Robinson Avenue: I was blessed to be with our brethren in Farmington.

Messages on unity are always needed and timely. Of all of the things that Jesus could have prayed just before his arrest, trial, and crucifixion unity was a high priority. Jesus asked: "I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all

of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one – I in them and you in me – so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that vou sent me and have loved them even as you have loved *me.*" I don't believe that Jesus was asking for something unattainable. As difficult and complex as the guest for unity might be it is not beyond God's power and ability.

We must be champions of unity. It starts right here in our own church family. Paul had this to say to the church in Corinth: "I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus *Christ, that all of you agree* 

with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united *in mind and thought.*" Unity doesn't necessarily mean uniformity, but it does mean that we come together on those things that matter most and that we love one another through times of conflict or disagreement. As we do this in our own immediate church family, and as we pursue unity with the larger body of Christ we are working toward the fulfillment of Jesus' prayer in John 17!
