Keith Kilmer - Good morning! We want to welcome everyone on this Lord's Day morning. Today promises to be a great day of worship, fellowship, and praise. We hope that you have come with a willing mind and an expectant heart. If you are visiting with us today, please stick around for a while after services and allow us the opportunity to get to know you – your presence is a great blessing to us.
