With great power, the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all that there were no needy persons among them..."

Notice some important characteristics of the church at this stage:

- They were unified. V.32 says they were one in heart and mind.
- They were generous. V.32 also tells us that they shared everything they had.

• They were growing. V.33 says that with great power they continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was powerfully at work in them all.

These are great benchmarks for the church in any location at any time in history. Are we unified in heart and mind? Are we generous with our time and resources? Are we growing because we have a passion to tell people about the risen Lord? Today is a day to come together as a church family and encourage and edify one another with the goal of being what God calls us to be.


