Church at its Best

The Bible gives us examples of high-functioning churches

A number of our families are away this morning for our second-annual family retreat. If you haven't participated in this event yet, please consider putting it on your calendar for next year. We have great opportunities for men, women, and teens to get away for spiritually uplifting retreats – the family retreat allows us to enjoy refreshing moments with our families in the presence of our brothers and sisters in Christ. It has been a great weekend.

Throughout the Bible, we get snapshots of various churches. Some churches, such as the church in Corinth, were plagued with problems. But we also get some glimpses of churches functioning at a high level. This is the picture we get of some of the earliest Christians. Acts 4:32-34

says “*All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. With great power, the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all that there were no needy persons among them...*”

Notice some important characteristics of the church at this stage:

• **They were unified.** V.32 says they were one in heart and mind.

• **They were generous.** V.32 also tells us that they shared everything they had.

• **They were growing.** V.33 says that with great power they continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was powerfully at work in them all.

These are great benchmarks for the church in any location at any time in history. Are we unified in heart and mind? Are we generous with our time and resources? Are we growing because we have a passion to tell people about the risen Lord? Today is a day to come together as a church family and encourage and edify one another with the goal of being what God calls us to be.
