## Indestructible!

God's Kingdom will never be destroyed

This morning we will conclude our Sunday morning study of the book of the Daniel. This is such an interesting and challenging book. In the first half of the book we got reacquainted with some familiar Sunday school stories such as the fiery furnace and Daniel in the lions' den. I suspect that our upcoming VBS will focus on these exciting stories and how they encourage and inspire us. The second half of Daniel has been especially challenging as we've looked at detailed prophecies that were given to Daniel hundreds of years before the events occurred. It has been faith-affirming to see the detail and accuracy of Daniel's visions – especially since we have the vantage point of living after their fulfillments.

Most of the dreams and visions in the book of Daniel have to do with Babylon and the world powers that would follow. But we are also told of a coming Kingdom that will never be destroyed. We read these words in Dan. 2:44: "...the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, nor will it be left to another people. It will crush all those kingdoms and bring them to an end, but it will itself endure forever." Every earthly kingdom is destined to fall but the Kingdom of God is an eternal kingdom. This is the Kingdom that we want to be a part of!

The Kingdom we belong to is not about power, position or prestige. Citizens of God's Kingdom live for his glory. We glorify God through

our lives, our words, and our worship. It's easy to get caught up in the ways of the world that we live in but our focus has to be on this eternal kingdom.

Being citizens of God's Kingdom even affects how we worship. The Hebrew writer says "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe." As we gather today it is important for us to remember this truth: God's kingdom cannot be shaken! Because of this confidence that we have we come humbly before God in worship today.
