Peter focuses on the willingness of an elder. He should be someone who serves not simply out of obligation or duty but because of a love for the flock and a passion for the kingdom. His leadership is not in the pursuit of power but is born out of the servant-heart of one who seeks to lead by example. Please be in prayer that we will find such men to serve alongside of our current shepherds!
