His Presence and His Peace

"The Lord is near... and the God of peace will be with you."

What an exciting day last Sunday! We're very blessed to now have Ron Dowdy, Pano Poulos and Marlyn Shafer as a part of our eldership. Remember the words that were read from Hebrews 13:17 on Sunday: "Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden..." Let's strive to make the role of shepherding a joy for our leaders.

As we inch closer to Christmas our current sermon series will focus on two things that are often meditated upon during this time of year: nearness and peace. The Christmas songs we sing remind of these truths; songs like O Come, O Come Emanuel remind of us how God has

come near to us through the birth of Christ while songs such as Silent Night speak to the peace that has as a result of Jesus' birth.

The passage that we are studying in Phil. 4: 4-9 has these promises as book-ends: "The Lord is Near" (v.5) and "The God of peace will be with you" (v.9). Nearness and peace two of the blessings of the incarnation are also practices that can help us to curb anxiety and worry in our lives.

The phrase "the Lord is near" can be taken in one of two ways. Is this a reference to the Lord's return or the Lord's presence? Might it be both? This is what we'll explore this morning in our study together.

It is always a good time to serve others but

this time of year seams to afford us with even more opportunities to do so. In recent weeks we've had opportunities to feed and clothe our neighbors, help underprivileged school children in our community, send gifts to kids in inner-city Atlanta, and assist orphans in Africa. These are opportunities to reflect and share the Lord's nearness and peace.
