Good morning everyone! Today’s service is a very special one for us. Today we will be worshipping with our Spanish speaking family. We are glad to be together!

This week we will be looking at Hebrews 3. In the two previous chapters, the writer of Hebrews elaborated on how Jesus is superior to angels, Moses, and the other prophets. He continues that thread through the first half of chapter 3. Beginning in 3:2, the author submits an analogy that I would like to run with. He says “Moses was faithful in all of God’s house.”

Imagine you are a great architect. Many of your projects have acquired renown and admiration. Your latest project is no different. In fact, this may be your very own Mona Lisa. When the house is unveiled and critics get a look at it, the response is one of awe-struck wonder. However, instead of praising you for your ability as an architect, they begin raving about the house itself and congratulating the construction team that actually built the home: foundation experts, framers, plumbers, electricians, roofers, etc. The workers deserve credit to be sure, but shouldn’t the people also admire the master architect who made it all happen?

In Hebrews 3, Moses represents the construction workers and Jesus is the master architect. The author of Hebrews makes the case that “Jesus has been found worthy of greater honor than Moses, just as the builder of the house has greater honor than the house itself. For every house is built by someone, but God is the builder of everything. But Christ is faithful as a son over God’s house. And we [the church] are his house.”

Moses laid the foundation that the church was built on, but Jesus is the master architect. He is greater than all others which was big news to the authors original audience. We are the recipients of that legacy: a master architect and those who helped make it a reality.
